# Introduction

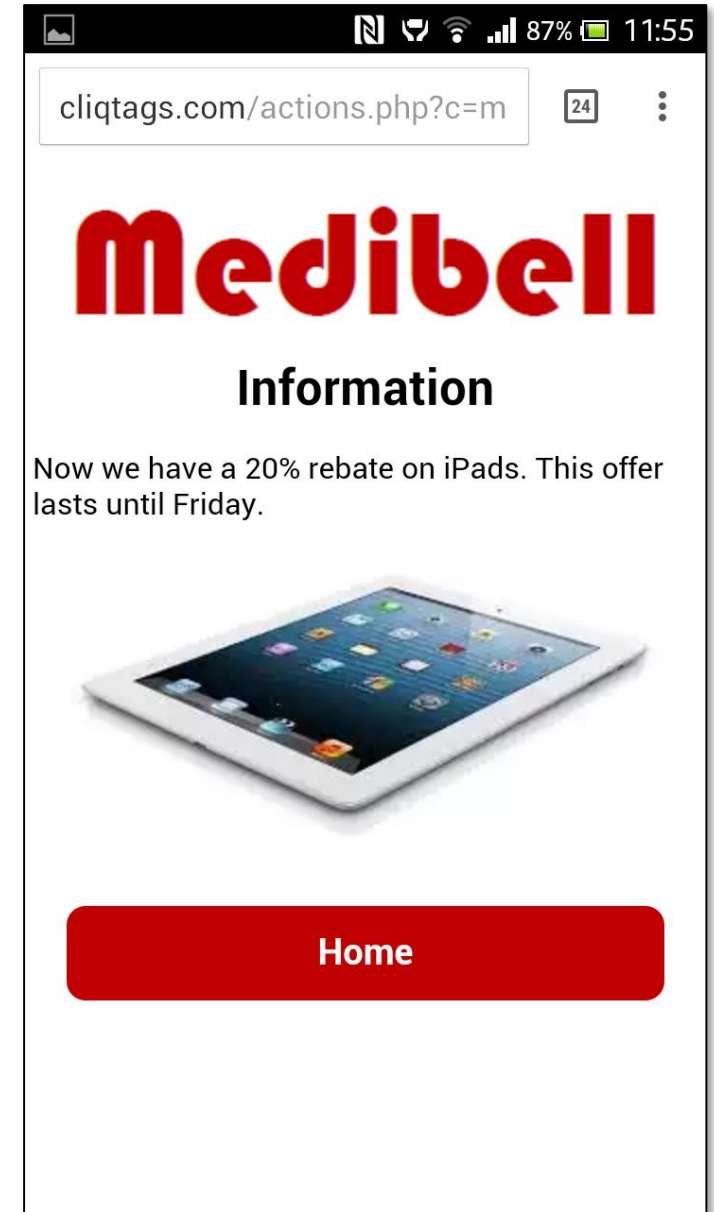
- When creating a new page, you can choose between 19 different page types, tailored to different types of content
- For all page types except Information, editing is structured like this:
  - Upper content
  - Content/settings related to the specific page type
  - Lower content
- Upper and lower content use the same WYSIWYG editor as Information, and can be used to explain the active content further

# Introduction

- Menus are automatically created based on the page hierarchy
- To create a higher-level page that is only a menu, we recommend Information
- Pages can be re-structured via **Edit** or directly in the list of pages
- **View** can be used at any time to show the result, without losing data

# Information

- Static information, possibly including pictures, tables etc
- Content can either be edited WYSIWYG, or in raw HTML via the HTML button
- Media can be inserted via buttons on the toolbar
- A media archive common for the account makes re-use of media easy



# Media

- Display of picture(s), video or audio
- Embeds content in a suitable way for each media type
- Interprets video IDs from YouTube and Vimeo
- Multiple pictures can be uploaded for a slideshow



# Contact

- Contact information, possibly from a vCard file
- Creates contact information based on entered information
- A vCard can be uploaded to fill the fields
- A vCard can be e-mailed from the mobile page

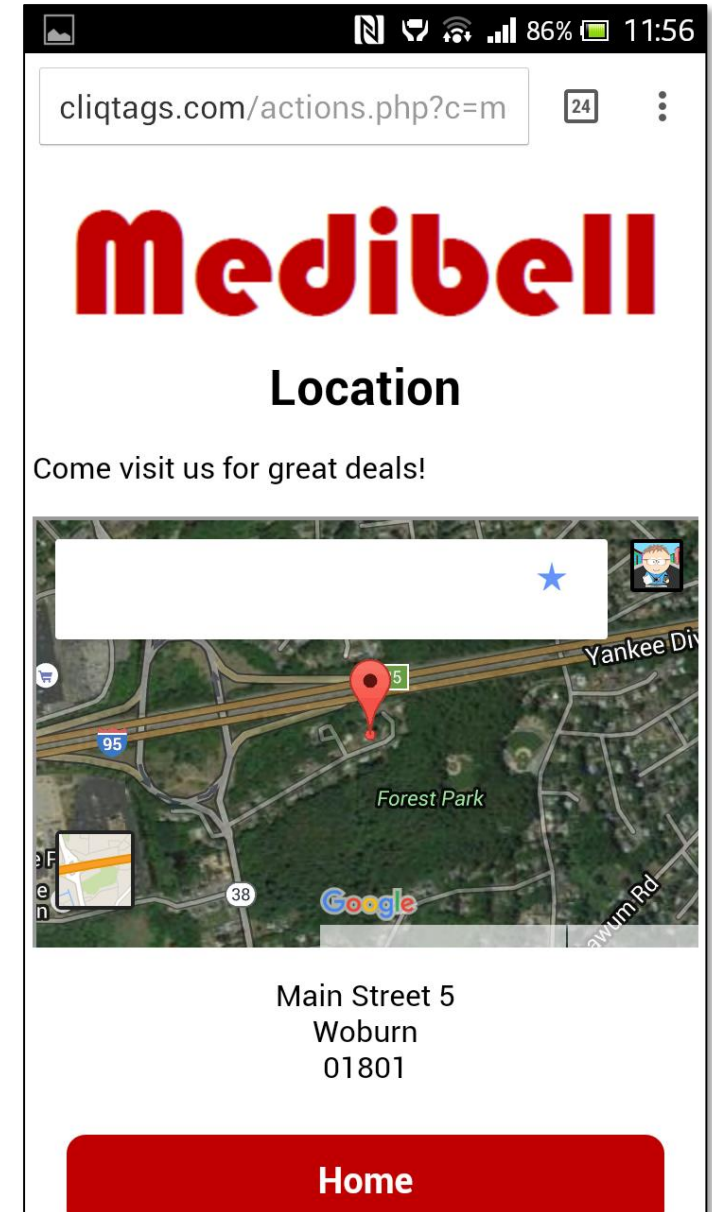


# Location

- Location shown using a dynamic map
- Based on navigation on a map or by entering coordinates, zoom and map type, it creates a map on the mobile page that can be further manipulated by the user
- The chosen location, zoom and map type will be reflected on the mobile page
- A marker always points to the assigned location, even when the map is moved



# Feedback

- Feedback form with predefined fields
- A basic feedback form for customers
- Responses will be collected under **Responses** as for Survey
- Feedback is using the same functionality as Survey





# Survey

- Survey form that you can populate with different types of fields
- Supports a wide range of field types (see Help)
- All responses are collected under **Responses**
- If an e-mail address is given, each response will be sent there as well
- It's possible to select:
  - Whether a field should be publicly shown
  - Whether a field is required; this will be shown with a \*

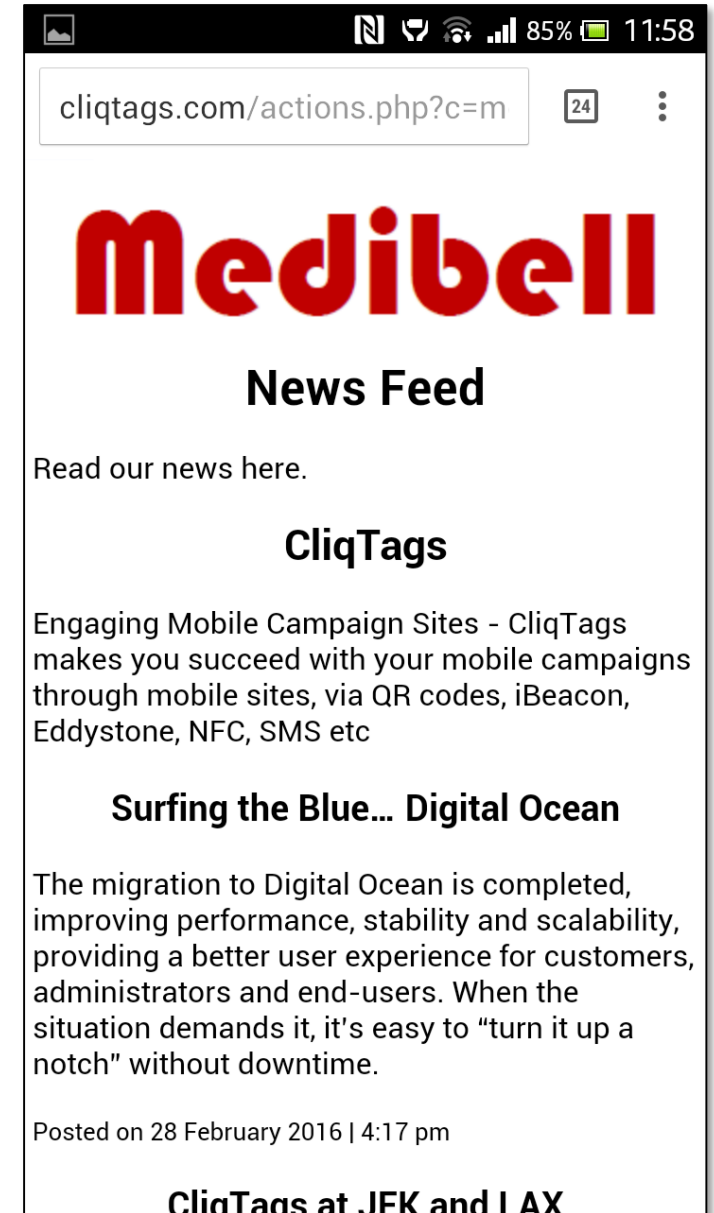

# News Feed

- News feed for a feed URL
- Based on a URL to a feed page it creates a formatted news feed
- It handles both RSS and Atom feeds
- Each time the page is accessed, the latest data is fetched



# Twitter Feed

- Twitter feed for a user name
- Creates a Twitter feed with clickable user names, hashtags and links
- Each time the page is accessed, the latest data is fetched



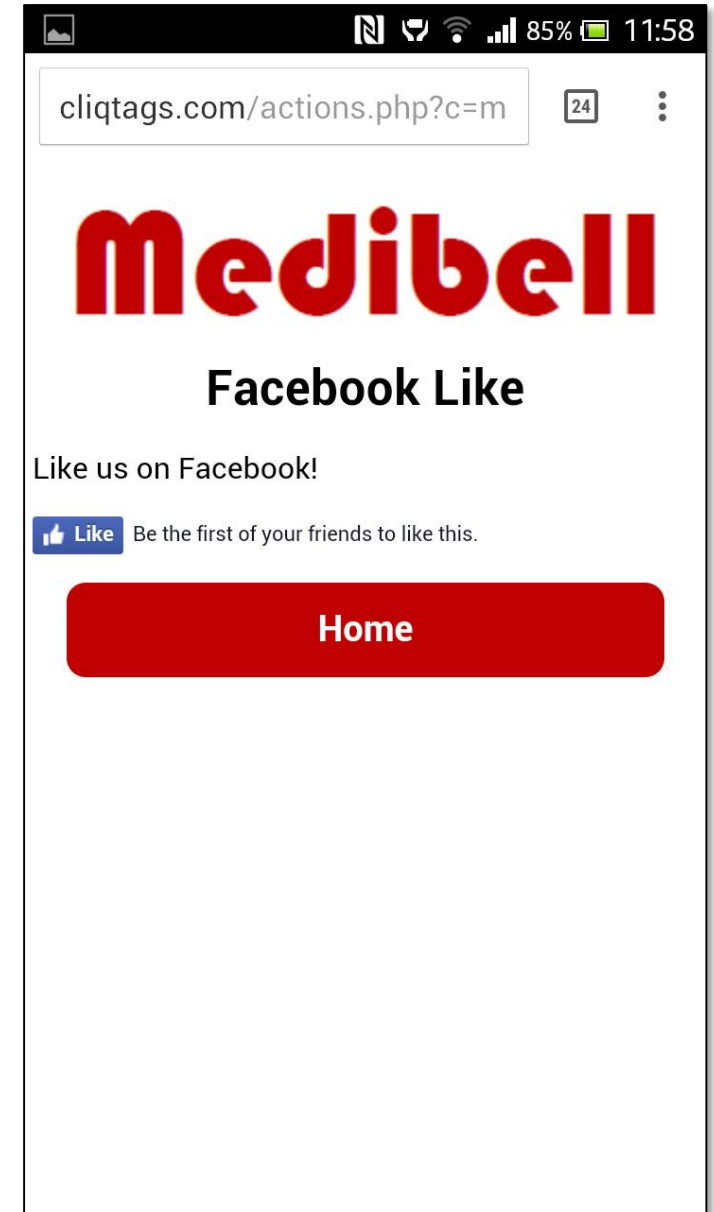
# Sharing

- Sharing of this or any other site
- Creates a page with sharing buttons and a QR code for this specific site (the default) or any other site



# Facebook Like

- Facebook Like for a site URL
- Creates a page with a Like button for any URL
- It uses Facebook's official widget



# Facebook Page

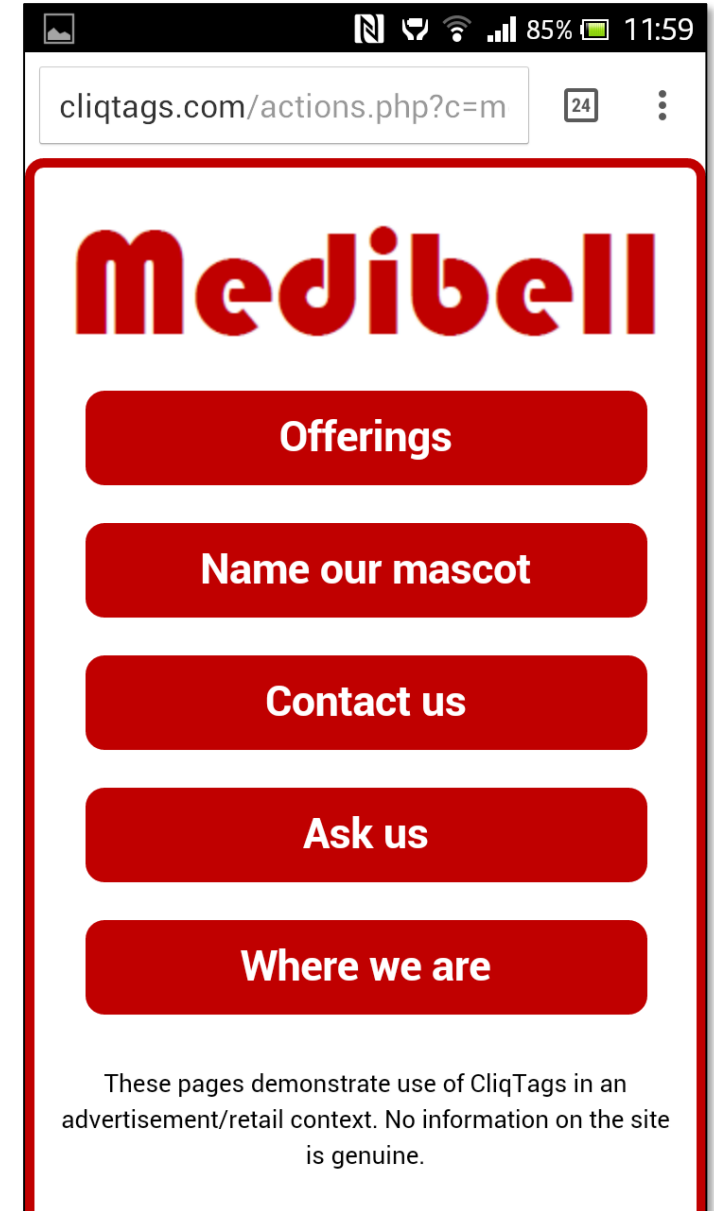
- Facebook Page for a page URL
- Creates a page with a clickable button that goes to the given Facebook Page





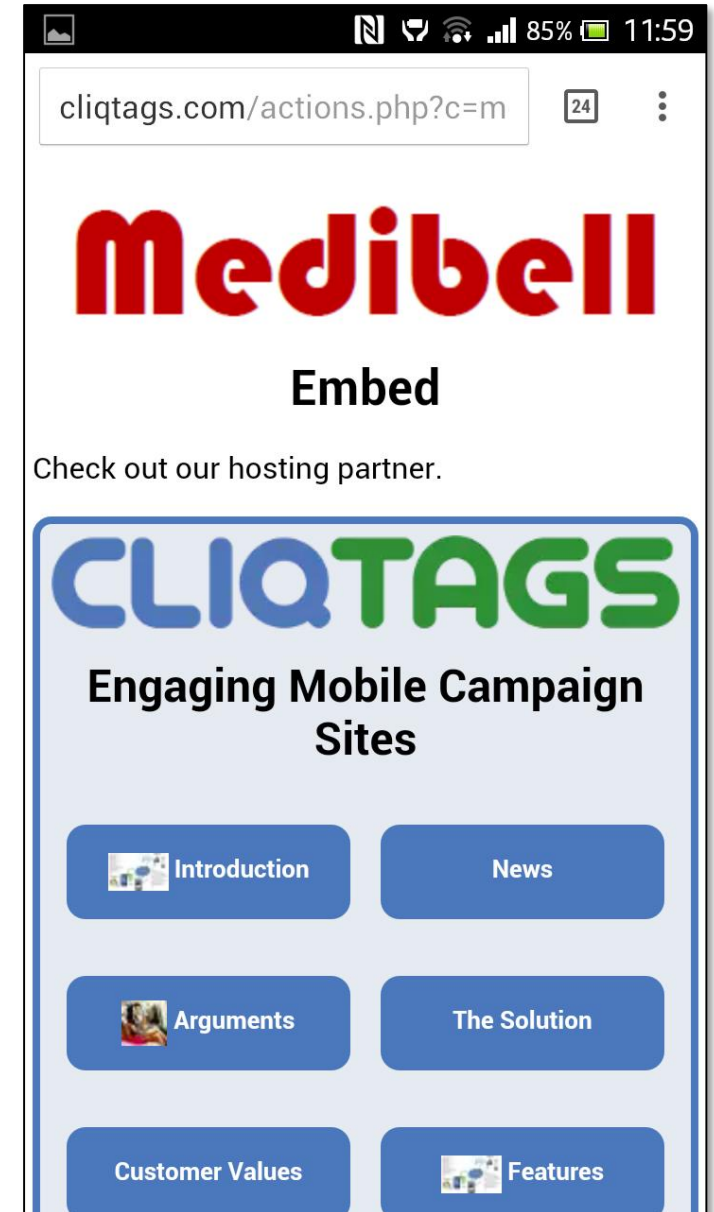
# Redirection

- Redirection to another site
- Redirects to any site without user intervention
- Often used to navigate to customer sites



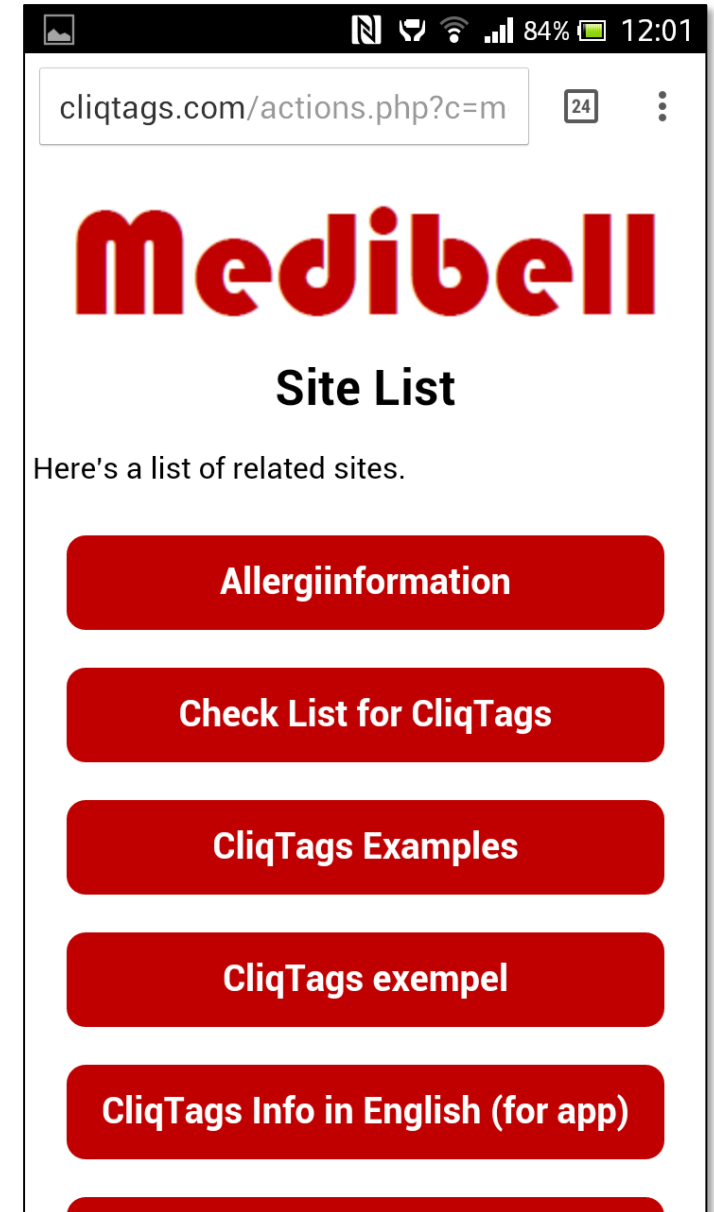
# Embed

- Embedded content from another site
- Enables embedding content generated by an external service, that way making it more or less transparent that external services are used
- Style can be inherited by requesting a stylesheet from CliqTags from the other service



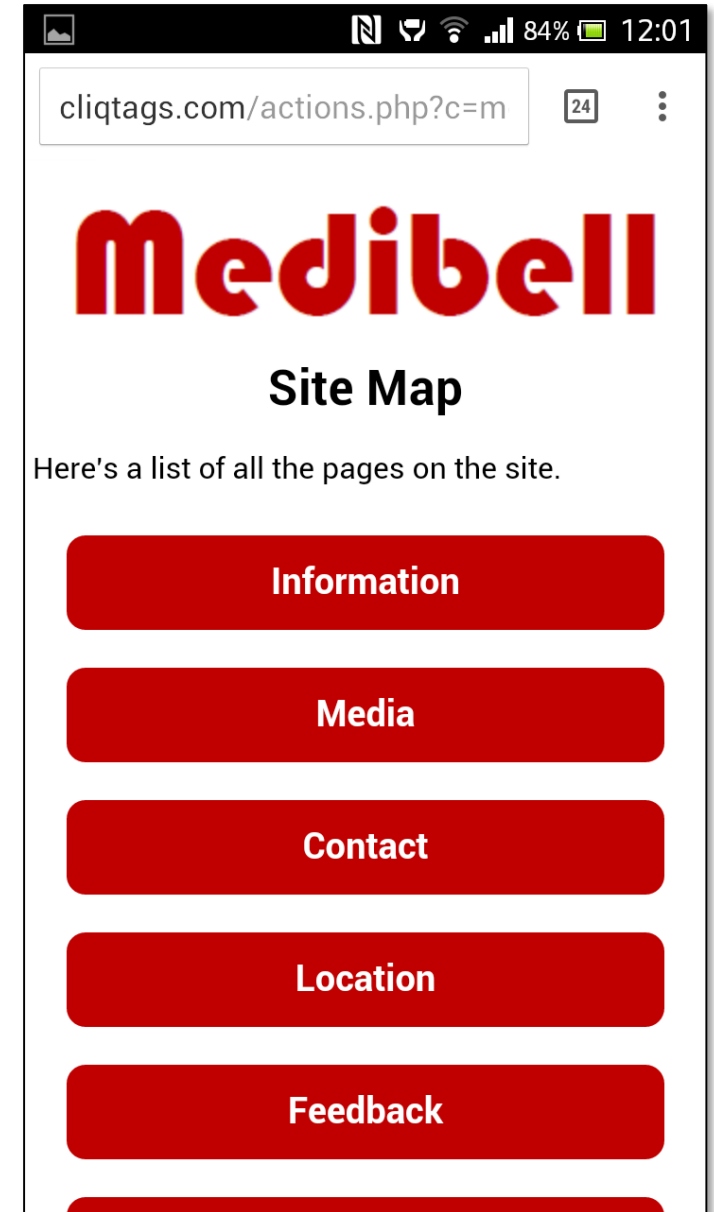
# Site List

- List of all sites on the account
- Creates one page with all the sites on the account
- Useful for e.g. collections of job offers, coupons and other thematic information, where also each site can be accessed individually




# Site Map

- List of all pages on this site
- Creates one page with buttons for all the pages on the site
- Mainly useful for very large sites
  - Sites should be easy to navigate without this



# Search

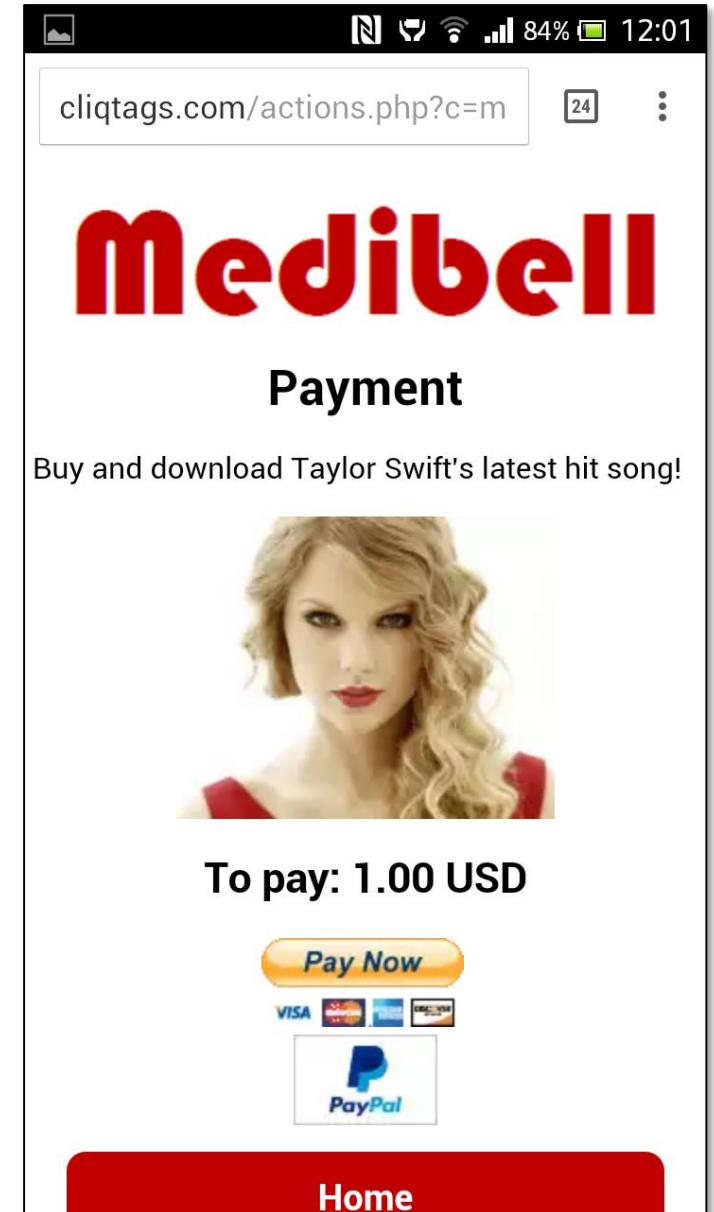
- Search form for content on the site
- Free-text searches the site and presents a page with buttons for each search hit
- Mainly useful for very large sites
  - Sites should be easy to navigate without this
